Describe a work of art as though you are talking about it to someone who cannot see the work.

Go back to the work of art you just looked at. Look again. Look for one minute. What do you notice now that you didn't notice before?

Choose a work of art near you. Which art movement does this work belong to? What can you say about the style of art you have encountered? Name 5 things you noticed.

Select a work of art. Which colours seem to come towards you, which seem further away? Which colours seem brighter?

Slow down the pace at which you look at a work of art. Imagine stepping into the image. What would the place look like? What would the atmosphere feel like? What sounds can you hear? What does this place smell like?

Pick a soundtrack, song or sound to accompany a work of art. What type of music would you select and why?

If this work of art were an animal, what would it be and why?

Select a work of art. Think or discuss what is happening in the work of art. What are some questions you have about the subject matter or technique? If you could ask the artist one question, what would it be?

Making a Chatterbox

- 1 Tear the square template from this instruction sheet.
- 2 Fold the square sheet you have in half to make a rectangle. (All dotted lines indicate where folds will be made).
- 3 Fold the rectangle in half to make a smaller square.
- 4 Unfold it and lay it so that the blank side is face up.
- 5 Fold each corner into the centre.
- 6 Turn the sheet over and fold each corner into the centre.
- 7 Fold this new square in half.
- 8 Slip your fingers under the paper tongues on the outside edges – pinch or pull – the chatterbox will begin to take shape as you do.
- 9 Have fun.

Using a Chatterbox

- 1 Ask someone to pick an art movement written on one of the square pockets.
- 2 Open and close the chatterbox by spelling out the word. eg C.U.B.I.S.M.
- 3 Choose one of the words written inside, then open and close the chatterbox by spelling out the word. Each letter will count as one open or close.
- 4 Choose another word. Open it and complete the prompt.
